### And that's a wrap for 2024!!!

Firstly, we extend a heartfelt thank you to all our sponsors, partners, and exhibitors who contributed to making this year's DAL Expo a resounding success.

**We welcomed approximately 5,300 visitors** over the two-day event, with 233 exhibitors joining us on the floor. While this attendance was slightly below last year's figures, it's an impressive turnout, especially given that both last year and this year's expos took place during the final week of school holidays.

We were thrilled to introduce a variety of new experiences this year. **Around 80 new exhibitors joined us**, bringing fresh perspectives and innovative booth displays that captured the imagination of attendees. To elevate the excitement, we added unique activities like a silent disco featuring sensory vests, a larger petting zoo, and a range of giant games that brought an extra layer of fun for all ages.

For the first time, art took centre stage at the DAL Expo. We partnered with **The Art of Expression to curate an art competition that drew in 45 stunning entries from 14 talented artists** who reminded us that ageing and living with a disability does not hinder talent, passion and inspiration.

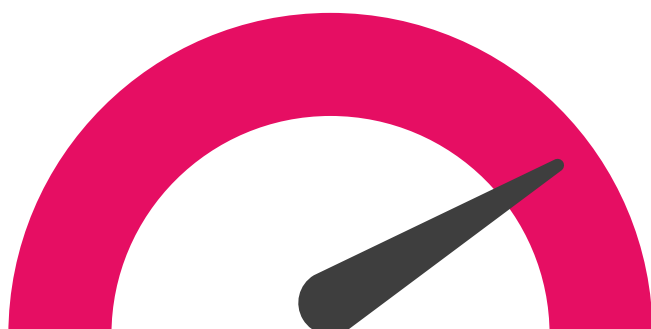

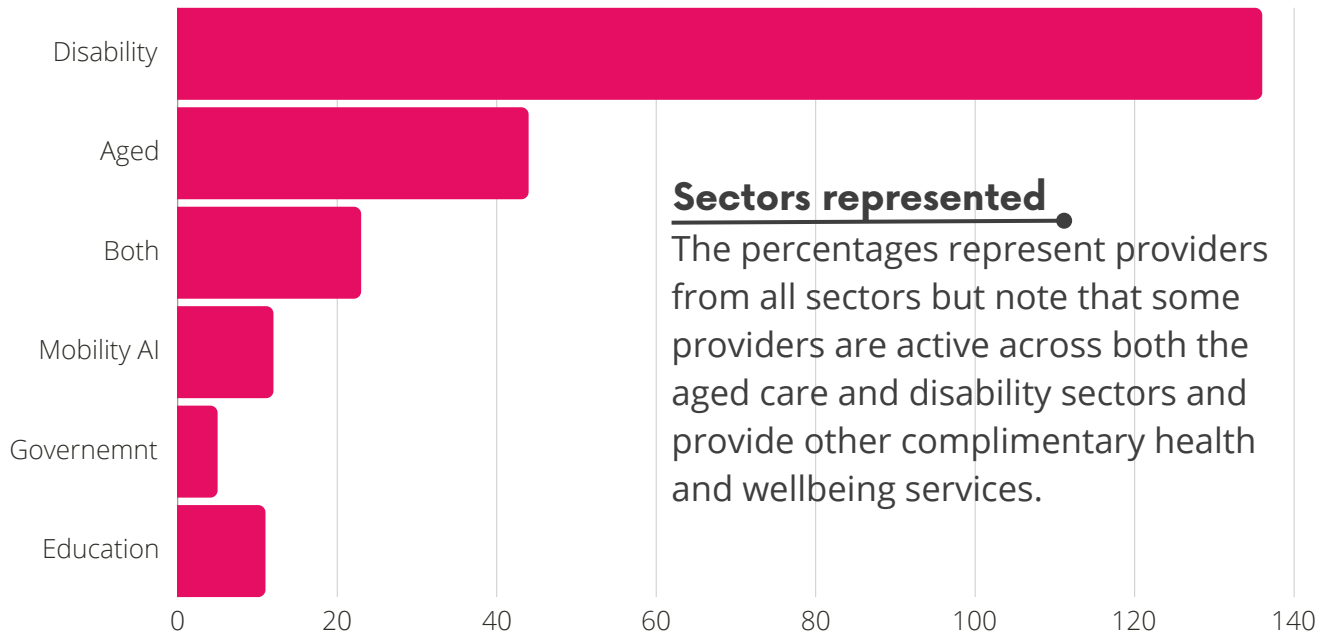
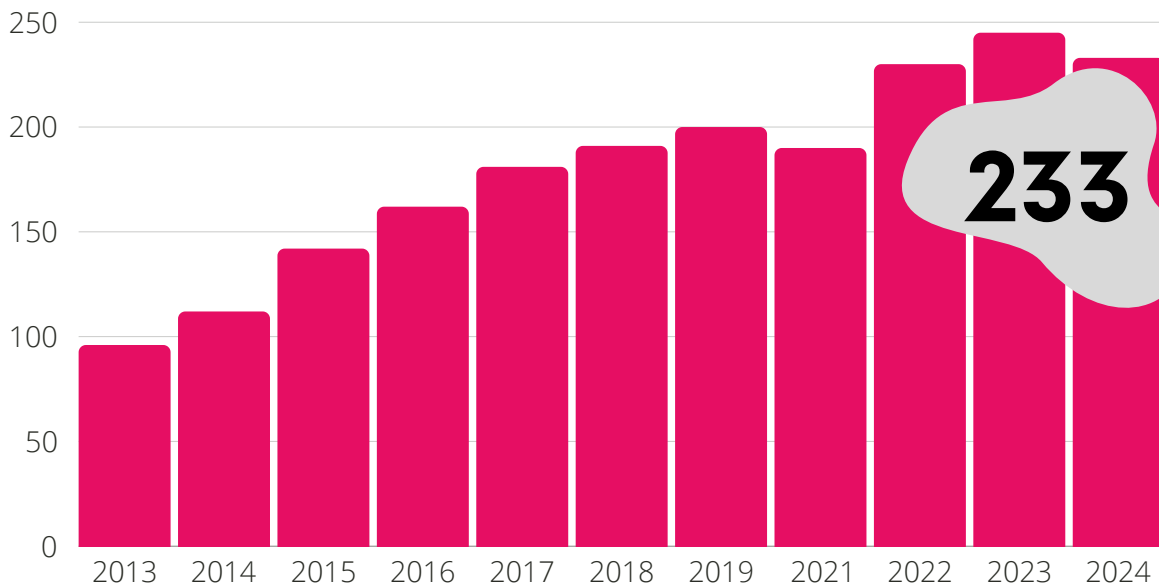

The percentages represent providers from all sectors but note that some providers are active across both the aged care and disability sectors and provide other complimentary health and wellbeing services.

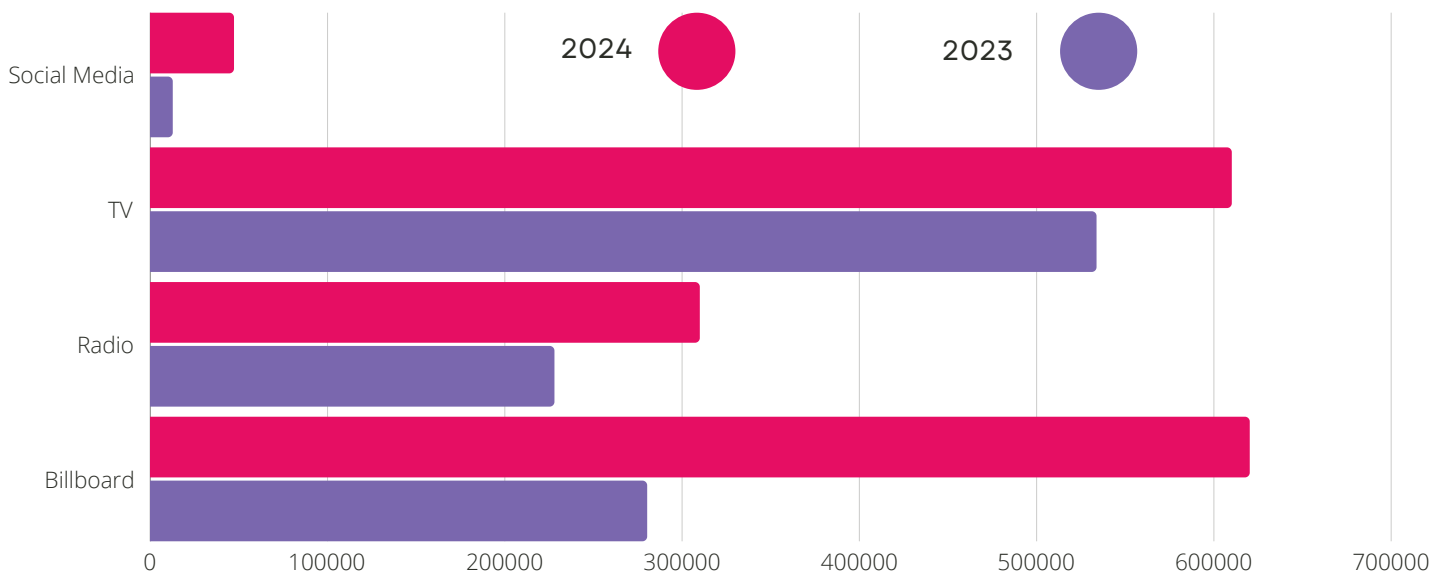
